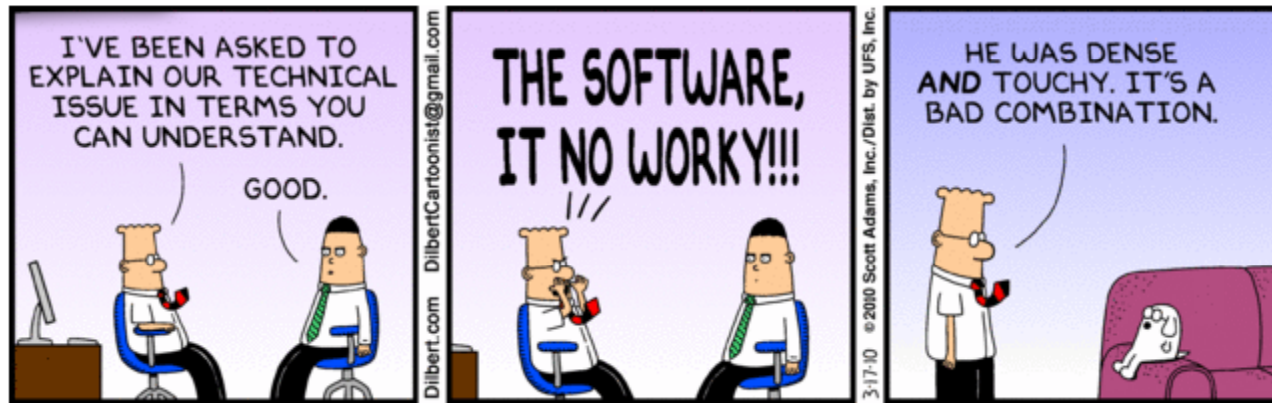

1. What is Business Analysis?

Business analysis is the set of tasks and techniques that work as a liaison among stakeholders to understand the structure, policies and operations of an organization, and recommend solutions that enable the organization to achieve its goals.*

1. It is structured
2. It strives to understand
3. It recommends solutions
4. It lives in a middle ground
5. It is business centric

1. What is Business Analysis?

The challenge

- ‘traditionally’ the BA has been an “IT” position

Leaders beginning to see value beyond IT

- not just technology focused
- but business centric

It is about helping the business achieve
its objectives

1. What is Business Analysis?

Business analysis is a simple concept. It involves analyzing the business and is about understanding:

- *Why the organization exists*
- *How an organization works*
- *What are its goals and objectives*
- *How it accomplishes those objectives*
- *How it needs to change to better accomplish objectives or to meet new challenges*

*The Business Analyst role is about linking and liaising. It goes broader than just IT, to focus on solutions in the context of the organization's goals. The BA role is about meeting business needs and ensuring investment in the right solutions. In other words, the problem or opportunity is the context of change to the organization.**

The BABOK® Guide describes Business Analysis areas of knowledge, their associated activities and the tasks and skills necessary to be effective in their execution. The BABOK® Guide is a reference for professional knowledge for Business Analysis and provides the basis for the Certified Business Analysis Professional™ (CBAP®) Certification.

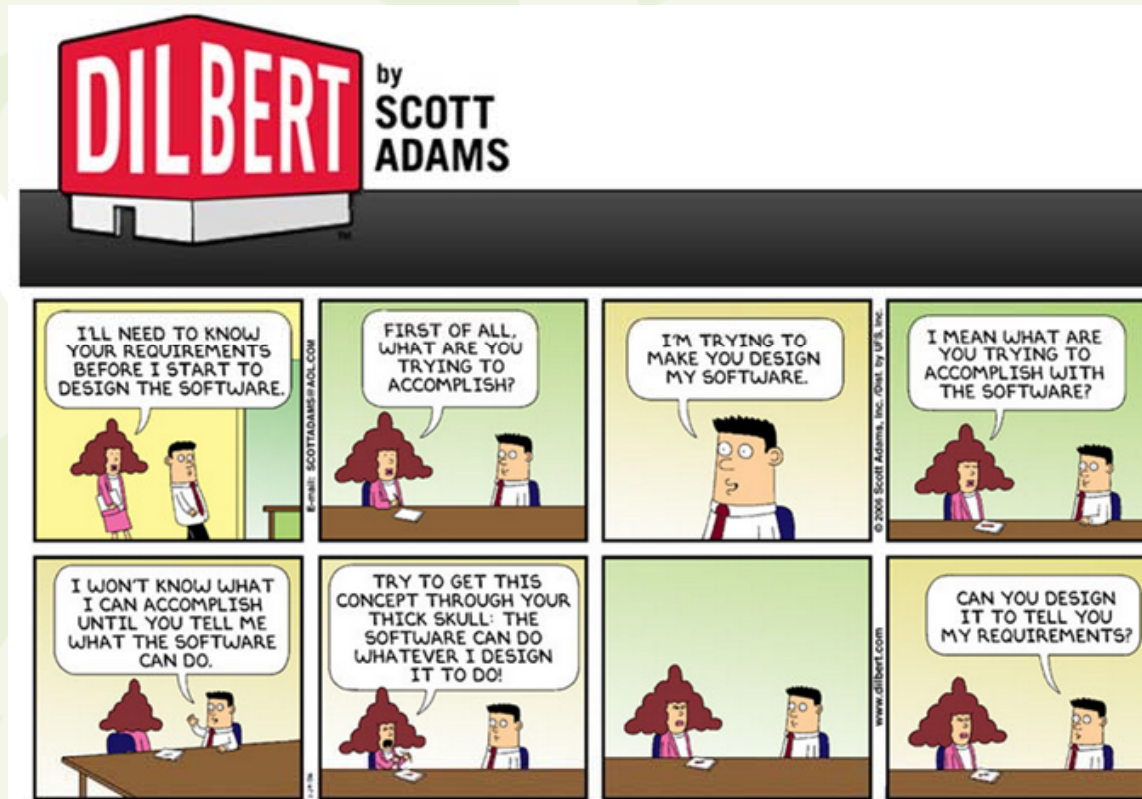

- Improve productivity!

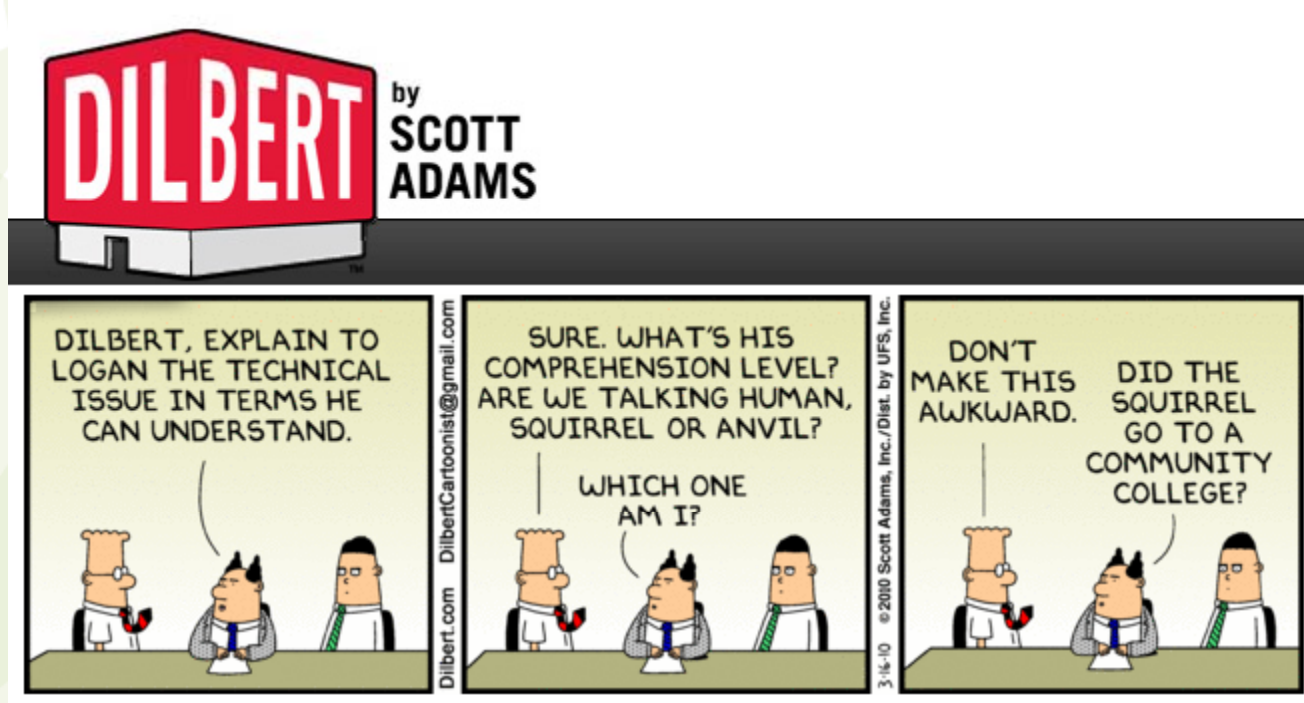
