- Loaners for international travel with data and voice (encouraging use of Lync)
- Managed with Good for Enterprise, BES, ActiveSync
- ActiveSync controls, , Group policies/AD

# Philosophy and policies toward mobility.



- How does ownership of the devices or the contract impact your use policies and security?
  - Does whom you are issuing to the device change this policy?
    - Securing data on the device
    - Containerization
    - Data wiping (lost device)
    - Departing attorney
- Do the policies drive how mobile devices are used?
  - Where have the policies been successful?
  - Where have the policies failed?

## Philosophy and policies toward mobility.



- Have client security requirements or government regulations affected your ability to adopt a more interactive environment with mobile devices?
- Have client business requirements caused you to quickly react and adopt capabilities not fully vetted?
  - Sync to public cloud
  - What employees are enabled
